- 1 GAMBLING SESSION = A visit to a Gambling Establishment
- 2 If you go to more than 1 Casino on a given day, you will have multiple Gambling Sessions for that day
- 3 BEGINNING CASH Count your Gambling Money before you go into the Casino, etc.
- 4 ATM WITHDRAWAL for more Gambling Money, enter in ATM column. KEEP YOUR RECIEPT & BANK STATEMENTS
- 5 If you hit a jackpot and they give you a W-2G, enter the total Withholdings from W2-G's for that Session in the Withholdings column
- 6 If you hit a jackpot and they give you a W-2G, enter the winnings amount in the W-2G Column.
- 7 ENDING CASH Count your Money when you leave the Casino, etc. INever count your money, when you're sitting at the table I
- 8 DO NOT pay for Meals, Drinks, etc. out of your Gambling Money. Use a Debit Card & keep the receipt to show how you paid for those things
- 9 Total Columns +A -B -C +D. If the result is a Positive #, enter in WIN column. If it is a Negitive #, enter in LOSS Column
- 10 Enter total winnings of all W-2G's received in the Gambling Session in the final column so we know what was reported to the IRS BRING ALL W2-G'S.
